



Philippians 2:5, 15



And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us...”




Beautiful Christians

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- They were a **praying people** (Acts 2:41-41, 3:1; 4:24)
- They were a **problem solving people** (Acts 6; 15:4-6)
- They were a **people in which women played a major role**: Lydia (16), Priscilla (18), Paul arrested men and women
- Women did not *“teach nor usurp authority over a man”* (1 Tim. 2:12); but 8 or more women labored in the Lord (Rom. 16:1-15)

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- They were a **sacrificial people** (Acts 2:42-44; 4:34-35)
- They were a **people steadfast in the midst of trials and persecutions** – *“They ceased not”*
- We must be willing to suffer hardship and not expect that life in Christ will always be comfortable and convenient.

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- **They were a people who loved one another (Acts 20:36-38).**
- **They were a people seeking truth (Acts 2:42).**
- **They were a people who spread the good news (Acts 8:4).**
